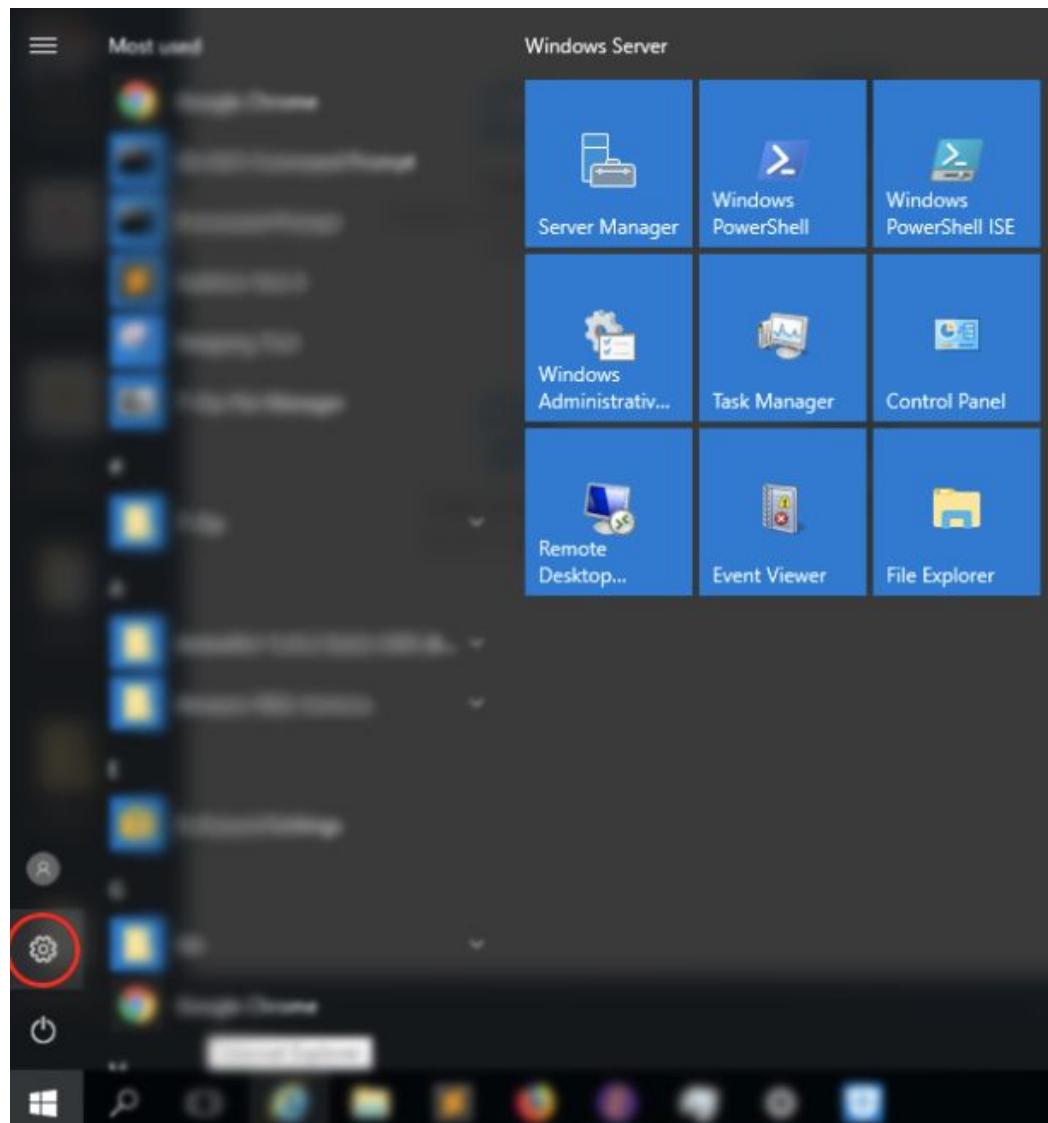
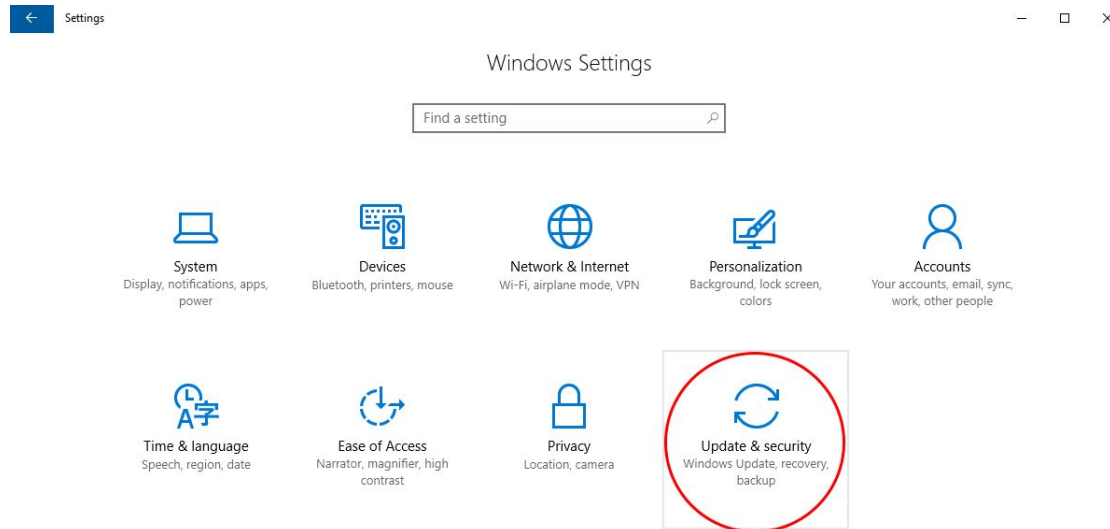


# Guide for Eigencoin Windows Wallets

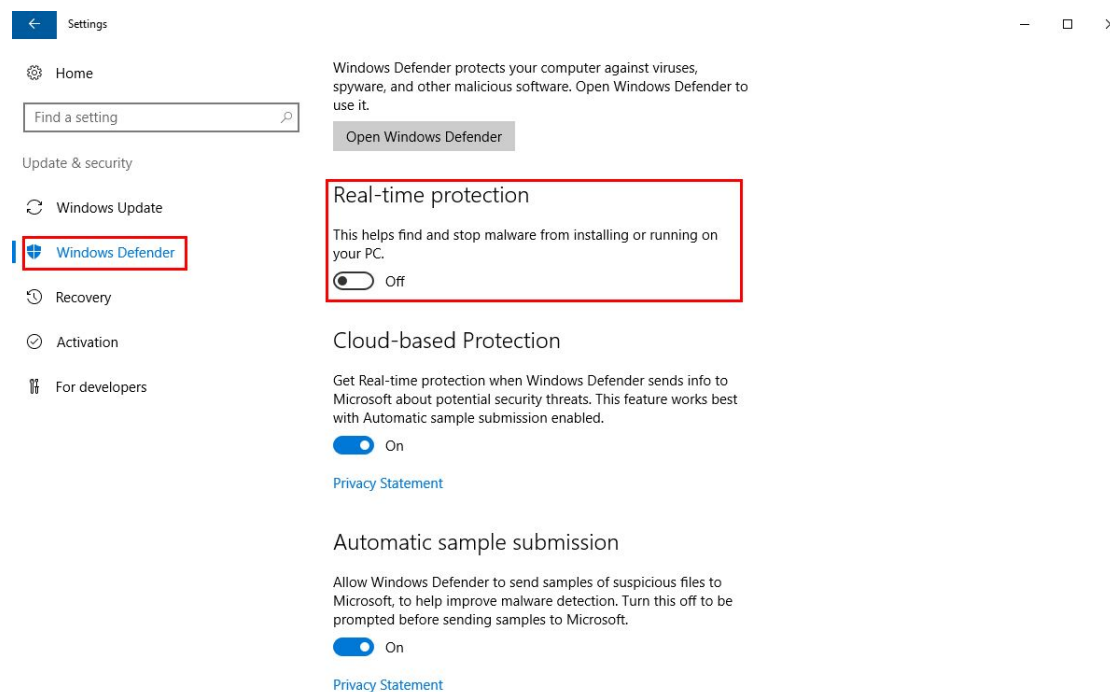
1. Click the Start button, then select the Settings gear.

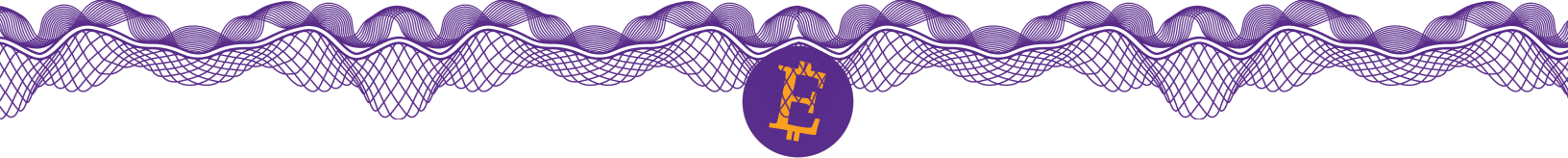


## 2. Click on Update & Security on the bottom right.



## 3. Click on Windows Defender on the left sidebar.



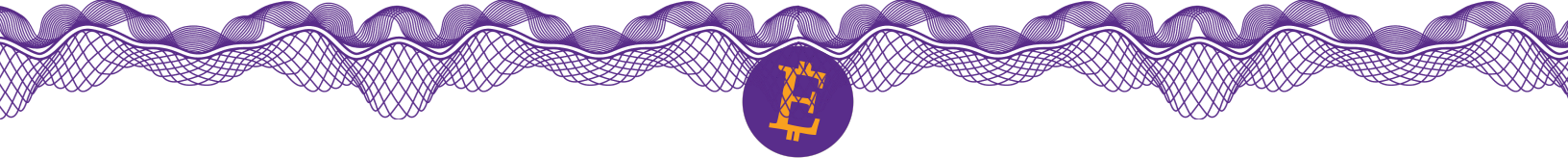


#### 4. Turn off Real-Time Protection. (You may turn this back on later)

#### 5. Download the wallet from Eigencoin's website.
